2015 Agriculture Week Poster Contest

A partnership between the Georgia Department of Education, the Georgia Department of Agriculture & Georgia Grown in celebration of the Governor's Agriculture Day and National Agriculture Week.

Eligibility

- · Any Georgia public school student enrolled in grades 6-12 for the 2014-15 school year is eligible to participate.
- · Each school is eligible to submit their top three posters to the Georgia Department of Education for state recognition.

Poster Guidelines

- · All posters should focus on the 2015 theme, "Agriculture in my county & state: What does agriculture do for me?"
- To be considered, posters should measure 18 inches tall and 24 inches wide. Posters larger or smaller than 18" x 24" may be disqualified.
- · Posters must be the original artwork and design of the student submitting the entry. Photographs, images and/or artwork copyrighted by other individuals, whether from publications or from the Internet, are not acceptable and may be disqualified.
- · Posters should be the effort of an individual student. Group/team entries will not be accepted.
- · Posters may be created using marker, crayon, paint pens, watercolor, ink, acrylic, colored pencil and/or tempera paint. Computer- or photo-generated art or printing will not be accepted. Collages are not acceptable. Please do not glue anything on the entry.
- · Posters may be mounted on foam or poster board, but should not be laminated or folded.
- · Posters should be mailed as flat documents. Please do not roll posters.
- The student who creates the poster should clearly list his or her name, grade, and school on the back of the poster.

Timeline

- · Posters should be created in correspondence with the Governor's Agriculture Day celebration on March 10, 2015, and the national Agriculture Week celebration on March 15-21.
- The top three posters from each school are due to the Georgia Department of Education no later than Friday, April 3. Posters must be received at the Georgia Department of Education by the April 3 deadline
- State winners will be announced via press release by April 17, 2015.
