<u>COLT – JULY (Camp John Hope - Fort Valley)</u>

July 9-11, 2025

Price: \$140 - Includes lodging Wednesday and Thursday night, meals, and conference materials.

Rigby's Additional Charge (OPTIONAL): \$27 – We have the opportunity again this year to spend Thursday night of the conference at Rigby's. Included in the 27 dollars is dinner, a drink, and the choice of what activities your students would like to participate in such as laser tag, bowling, skating, mini golf, and arcade games! You will have to travel there and back in your own vehicle. If you choose to forgo the trip to Rigby's you can use this portion as extra team time. Rigby's will only be offered for the July COLT Conference. If there is low participation through registration when evaluated Friday the 16th, we will rearrange the schedule and remove the Rigby's trip as an option.

<u>COLT – AUGUST (FFA-FCCLA Camp – Covington)</u>

August 8-9, 2025

Price: \$75 - Includes lodging Friday and Saturday night, meals, and conference materials. Keep in mind this conference is shorter in length, which does not allow for quite as much team time.

NOTE FOR BOTH CONFERENCES:

Both conferences will offer similar content and activities. Everyone in attendance should bring the following items:

- •Appropriate casual clothing •Appropriate clothing for water activities, mud course, and/or recreation
- •Calendar/planner and other chapter materials needed for team time
- •Official FFA Dress

COLT at the FFA-FCCLA Camp in Covington will have 250 seats available, while COLT at Camp John Hope in Fort Valley will have 150 seats available. Registration will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. **No refunds will be issued once we are 2 weeks out from each conference.** There will be no lodging/meals cost for non-advisor chaperones. <u>Chapters are to bring a chaperone for each gender and have a ratio of one adult per 10 students.</u> If you do not bring a chaperone you will need to arrange for another advisor present to serve as the chaperone in the cabin. As always, there is no cost for bus drivers. Additional T-shirts for bus drivers and chaperones are \$10 each.
